

BYLAW NO. 2013-7

**REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON
A PORTION OF RANGE ROAD 2064**

**A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Browning No. 34,
in the Province of Saskatchewan, being a Bylaw
to Regulate the Speed of Motor Vehicles on the portion of
Range Road 2064 East of the NE 17 and East of Section 20-5-6-W2M.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Browning No. 34, in the Province of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 12 of *The Municipalities Act*, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than sixty (60) kilometers per hour on the municipal road described as follows:
 - a. That portion of Range Road 2064 located East of the North East Quarter of Section 17 and East of Section 20-5-6-W2M.
2. Signs indicating the maximum speed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
3. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
4. **This bylaw comes into effect upon approval of The Highway Traffic Board.**
