1. Statutory Holidays and Closures

1.1. The following days shall be recognized as a public holiday:

New Year's Day
Family Day
Good Friday
Victoria Day
Canada Day
Saskatchewan Day

Labour Day
Thanksgiving Day
Remembrance Day
Christmas Day
Boxing Day

- 1.2. When a designated public holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the Administrator shall advise all employees when the public holiday is to be taken. Generally, if the public holiday falls on a Saturday, the holiday will be taken on the Friday preceding that date. If the public holiday falls on a Sunday, the holiday will be taken on the Monday following that date.
- **1.3.** If urgent work arises on a public holiday which forces the R.M. to call employees to work, those who work on that public holiday may be entitled to holiday pay for that day. This pay will be calculated per the appropriate Provincial Labour Legislation.
