BYLAW NO. 2022-1

INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE FEE BYLAW

A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Browning No. 34, in the Province of Saskatchewan, being a Bylaw to Establish a Infrastructure Maintenance Fee

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Browning No. 34, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw shall be cited as The Infrastructure Maintenance Fee Bylaw.
- 2. Every oil company shall, before commencing wellsite preparation and drilling operations for a new wellsite, pay to the municipality a fee of two thousand, five hundred (\$2,500.00) dollars as an Infrastructure Maintenance Fee.
- 3. The two thousand, five hundred (\$2,500.00) dollars fee will cover the cost of any gravel, extra road maintenance and overweight permits for all equipment entering the lease during the drilling and completion of the well which includes the service rig and fracturing equipment, but does not include any equipment to prepare the wellsite; and, once the well is active, any further work is classified as maintenance and subject to overweight permits and fees.
- 4. Bylaw No. 2019-6 is hereby repealed.
