
Public Works / Relations Committee

The Public Works / Relations Committee is made up of 2 division council members designated to receive employee concerns and complaints.

The purpose of the Public Works / Relations Committee is to discuss questions and problems concerning employer/employee relations. All questions and concerns brought forward are kept confidential, unless the employee is considering harm to themselves, involves a matter criminal in nature, or if the employees give express permission to release some or all of the information.

The committee meets at the request of 1 or more employees. The request to meet is made by the employee directly to one of the committee members, or at the behest of the Reeve, Administrator or Foreman. Employees should address concerns directly with the Foreman or Administrator, if possible, before approaching the Public Works / Relations committee.

The designated committee members are appointed for four (4) month terms: January to April, May to August and September to December as set out yearly in the Rates and Appointments.
